Easter Weekend




We have a full weekend at Dumont Hill this weekend! Several JROTC platoons from the surrounding area will be participating in an Orienteering Meet Saturday morning. Orienteering is a sport that combines map reading, compass skills and a race component. We will start our Orienteering Egg Hunt for kids age 10 to 18 at 1 p.m. The folks with Orienteering Louisville will provide the compasses and maps, so participants only need a basket or bag to collect their eggs at each control point.

We are trying to introduce orienteering to Allen County, so all participants will receive an Easter goody bag regardless of their time for completion.

Additionally, our traditional Easter Egg Hunt registration will start at 1 p.m. Participants will be divided into groups walkers through age 3, 4 through 6, 7 through 8, and 9 through 10. All participants will receive a goody bag. Three prize eggs are included per age group the hunters who retrieve them will receive a premium cinch sack full of books and toys. We will also be giving away two grand prizes that include a two-pound chocolate Easter bunny and an Orb Odditeez Slimiball.
